Park Information

All cabins, amenities block & BBQ area are strictly NON SMOKING.

- Damages:** We have a 'user pays for damages policy'. Negligent damage caused by a guest such as scratches, permanent marks, dents or stains to walls, floors or soft furnishings will be charged to the credit card of the registered guest for that room for the cost of the repair.
- Smoking:** All accommodation, indoor areas and BBQ areas are non smoking. To protect the integrity of our non-smoking rooms we will charge \$200 to the credit card of the registered guest when smoke odour is detected in a room or cabin. This charge is to cover the cost of laundering all soft furnishings and carpet.
- Speed Limit:** WALKING PACE to ensure the safety of children and other park patrons.
- Conduct:** Noise should be kept to a minimum at all times and should cease by 10.00pm.
- All people in the park have a right to a peaceful and quiet stay. Excessive noise (anything audible from an adjoining site), unruly behaviour or bad language will not be tolerated and offending persons will be required to leave immediately without refund fees. Please ensure that pre-school aged children are supervised by an adult when using the amenities block and the play equipment.
- For safety reasons bikes and scooters must be ridden at a safe pace and they must NOT be used after dark. Skateboards and rollerblades are NOT permitted in the park (again for safety reasons).
- Tokens:** The laundry facilities and BBQ's operate with tokens which are available from the reception. BBQ \$1 for 15 minutes / Washer \$3 per load / Dryer \$1 for 18 minutes
- Rubbish:** Please wrap all garbage and place in the wheelie bins provided. RECYCLING containers are provided for the collection and recycling of glass, plastic, cans and paper. No cleaning of fish is permitted in the park.
- Responsibility:** All persons enter the park at their own risk and are responsible for their own possessions.
- Fires:** Solid fuel fires including head beads and Weber type units are not permitted at any time in the park.
- Public Telephone:** The nearest public telephone is located on the Princes Hwy opposite the Caltex Service Station.

Emergency Evacuation Procedures

IN THE EVENT OF A FIRE, FLOOD OR GAS LEAK THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES SHOULD BE FOLLOWED

POLICE / FIRE / AMBULANCE 000
- When instructed by staff all partons and visitors should proceed to the nearest evacuation area as designated on the park map. This area should be the furthest area from the hazard.
- All guests and visitors should remain in the area until otherwise instructed by staff.
- Vehicle and pedestrian exits are shown on the park map.
- Location of fire hydrants and hoses are indicated on the map. There is a small fire extinguisher in every cabin and a large one in the laundry.

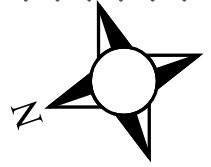
